The attention of applicants is drawn to the relevant criteria in Section 6(2) of the *Radio and Television Act, 1988*, as amended by the *Broadcasting Act 2001* (“the Acts”) and to the duties that will be imposed on the successful applicant under the various provisions of the Acts. The closing date for receipt of applications is **12noon on Friday, 21st September 2007**.
